IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- ✓ Make wise choices that support your career journey when you leave IA.
- ✓ Find out about the entry requirements needed for any jobs or College or University courses that you are considering. Make sure this is up-to-date e.g. Dentistry.
- ✓ Choose subjects you are good at and enjoy and that suit your abilities.
- ✓ In S3, think about what grades your teachers have given you in your final report (due out shortly).
- ✓ In S4 and S5, use your exam results carefully progress in the subjects where you have been successful.
- ✓ Be realistic about what you are able to do there is little point in taking a subject which has caused you serious difficulty in the past.
- ✓ Discuss your options with other people. Ask them for information, help and advice...

...but remember that YOU must make the final decision for yourself.

OPTIONS STRUCTURE - NUMBER OF SUBJECTS

Senior phase covers S4, S5 & S6. Therefore, all/any of your classes can contain pupils from any of these 3 year groups.


Pupils must follow a set number of courses in S4, S5 and S6 as indicated below:


- S4 English/ESOL and Maths plus 4 courses must be selected at levels 3-5
- 55/6-5 courses must be selected if not studying any courses at L7
- S6 only -5 courses (minus one for each Level 7 course to a minimum of 3)

S4 & S5 should also note that they are not permitted to 'crash' new subjects unless specifically agreed with subject and Guidance teachers. You must make choices based on the subjects you are already taking. 'Crashing' is only available in S6.

*S6 are expected to use any free columns gained from AH study productively and will be offered volunteering, placement and work experience opportunities in August.



- Majority takes 2 years to complete and is same level as a Higher (SCQF Level 6)
- During the course you will spend time out of school at college and with a local employer


Why choose a Foundation Apprenticeship?

The information below is for Guidance as you prepare to make your final choices. When choosing your courses, you must decide what subjects and level of course would suit you best. To help you make your choice, you should consider your abilities, future career needs and interests as these will determine which pathway you should follow.

You should find out which courses and levels of qualification are needed for the college, university, apprenticeship or employment pathway you have in mind. Do not assume you know what they expect; you could be surprised by some of the entry requirements so ensure you have done your research before making your choices.

Discussing your ideas and research with subject teachers can also be of huge benefit as they know a great deal about the pathways linked to curricular areas.
