Parent Guide To The New Termly Profiles

The Termly Profiles were devised after a consultation with all parents/carers. We hope you find the new format of reporting more concise, useful and informative.

- The Termly Profile is split into three curricular areas: Literacy, Numeracy and Health & Wellbeing.
- Each area contains your child's learning targets for this term. The teacher has indicated how well your child is progressing. Your child has discussed with the teacher how they feel they are progressing. The targets are linked to the Benchmarks for each level, please look on the school website (in 'Curriculum') for more information.
- There is also a section for effort for Literacy, Numeracy, Health & Wellbeing and Homework, there is also a 'teacher comment' at the end of the profile.
- The teacher has specified the level that your child is working on at the moment.

This is a guide to the expected levels of progress. Some children may be working below or beyond the expected level. It would normally take a child three years to be secure in a level.

Expected levels

P1 - Early Level (E2 & E3 - secure at the end of P1)

P2 - First Level (1.1)

P3 - First Level (1.2)

P4 - First Level (1.3 - secure at the end of P4)

P5 - Second Level (2.1)

P6 - Second Level (2.2)

P7 - Second Level (2.3 - secure at the end of P7)

Attached to the profile is a feedback sheet for yourself and your child to complete. We would like your child to write comments about their progress independently if possible. Parents of children in P1 and P2 can write the comments for them.

You can speak to the class teacher in more detail about the targets and progress at the parents' evenings in November and May. We look forward to sharing the progress of your child's learning journey with you then.
