## Acrostic Poetry

In an Acrostic Poem the first, last or other letters of each line spells a word or phrase related to your Keyword.

- ▶ The keyword is written vertically in bold or colored letters.
- ▶ Try to use lots of adjectives and verbs
- ▶ Horizontal words do not always have to start with the first letter of the vertical word you can use any letter from the word.

### TOP TIPS FOR WRITING AN ACROSTIC POEM

Write your word or words down vertically when planning. Brainstorm words or phrases that describe your idea.

Place your brainstormed words or phrases on the lines that begin with the same letters. Fill in the rest of the lines to create a poem. Horizontal words do not always have to start with the first letter of the vertical word you can use any letter from the word.
