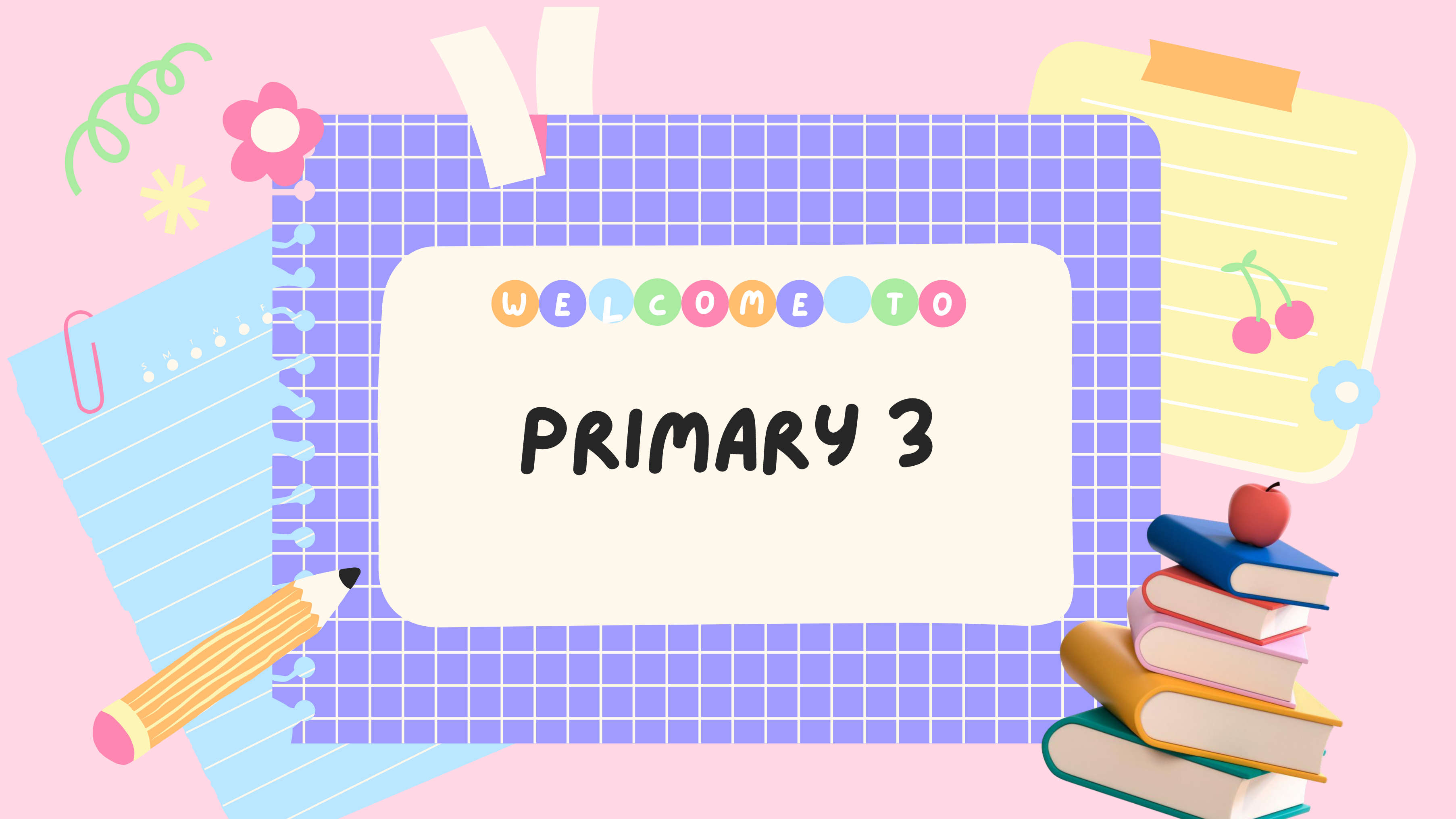

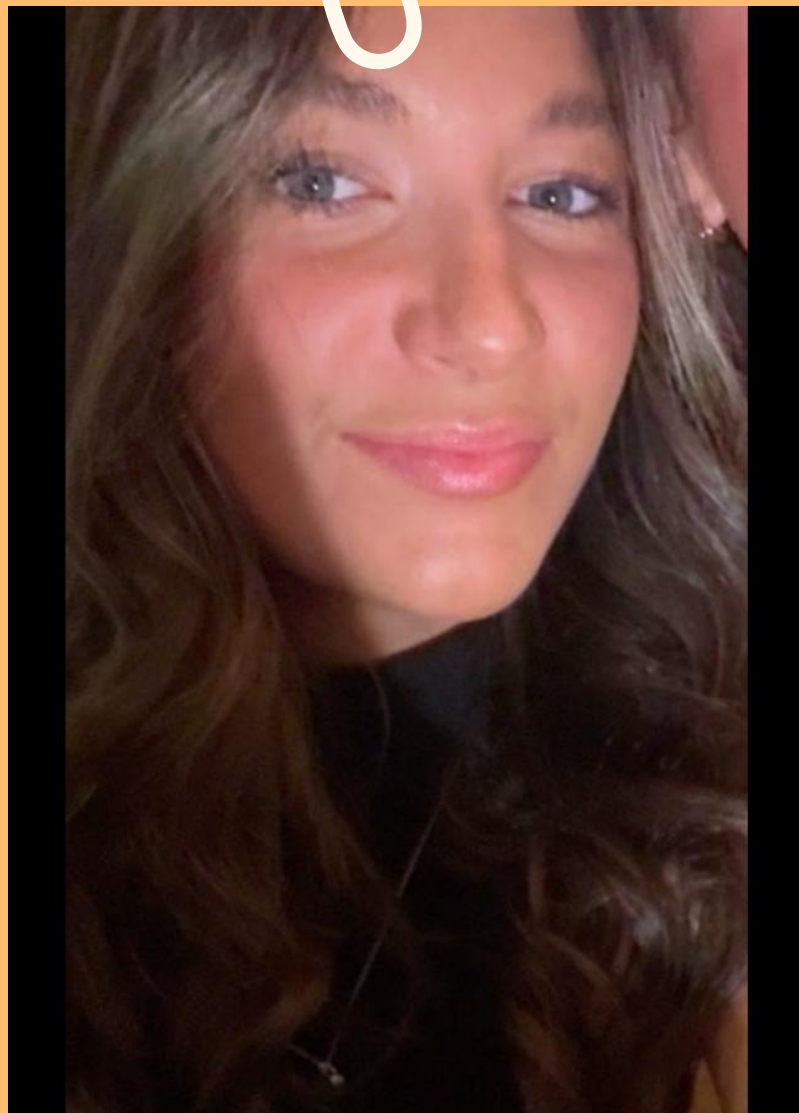
Hello primary 3...

I cannot wait to meet all of your lovely faces!

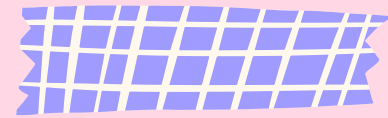




GET TO KNOW MISS CRAWFORD

When I'm not at school I like to be outdoors, going for walks and reading.

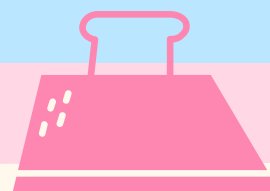

Here is how you will enter and exit your classroom.

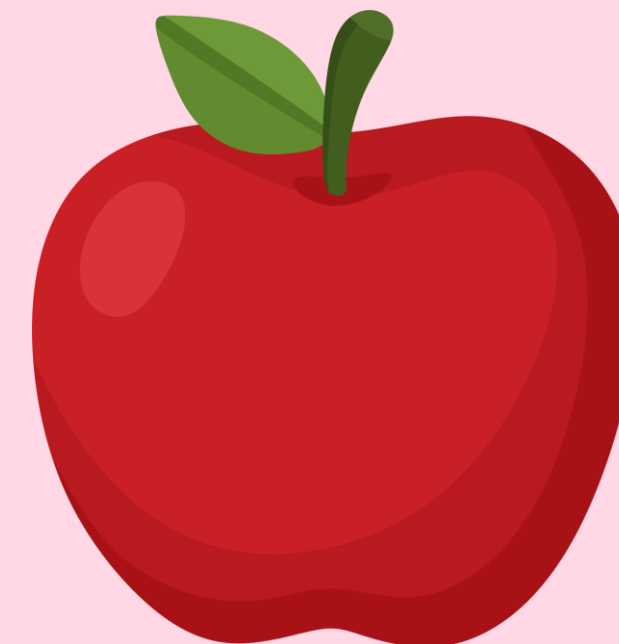


What to bring to school

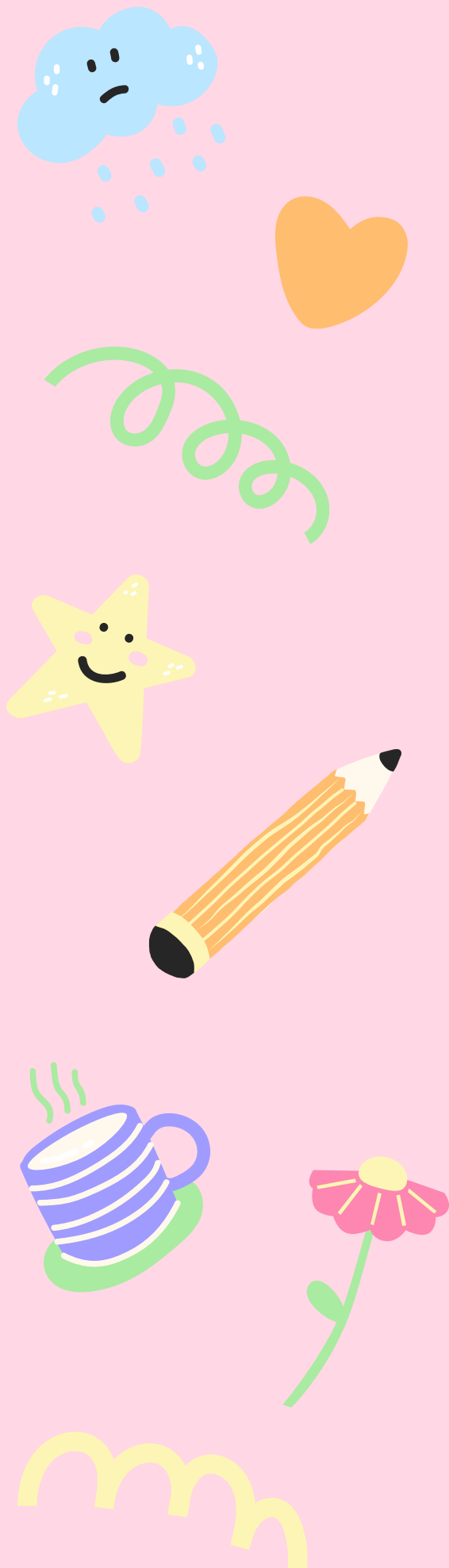
A water bottle

UNIFORM

Full School uniform

- Boys: grey trousers/shorts
- Girls: grey pinafore/skirt or tartan pinafore/kilt or blue summer dress.
- Boys & Girls: white shirt and school tie, navy school (or plain) sweatshirt/ sweater/ cardigan/ fleece.

Relaxed school uniform

- Navy leggings/joggers (no branded items).
