<p data-bbox="116 174 432 241">Language and Literacy including French</p> 	<p data-bbox="459 174 1479 241">Reading- we will continue to learn to read single sounds and blend them to make new words. We will also be learning more common words.</p> <p data-bbox="459 275 1479 365">Writing- we will be learning the correct letter formation for the sounds we are being taught. We will be using our blending skills to write new words. We will learn to write some more common words. We will begin to write simple sentences using the word skills we are learning.</p> <p data-bbox="459 409 1240 432">Talking and Listening- we will be retelling stories and sharing our ideas.</p> <p data-bbox="459 477 1139 499">French- we will be learning how to say some simple greetings.</p>

Her books are great to read and full of rhyme. We will do lots of activities to help us with rhyming. Some of the books we will be reading are seasonal so we will be learning more about Autumn and Winter. We will have the opportunity to take part in lots discussions, expressing our thoughts, ideas and feelings. We will be doing lots of fun arts and crafts to complement what we are learning.</p> <p data-bbox="459 1104 1455 1171">In social studies, we will be learning about different weather, how it affects us and how we feel about it. We will look at and record the weather too.</p> <p data-bbox="459 1205 1455 1294">In Science we will be learning water and day and night. We will be investigating water and its properties and learning about its three main states. We will be learning about the earth and how it spins around the earth and looking at the pattern of day and night.</p> <p data-bbox="459 1339 1455 1406">In technologies and digital learning, we will continue to learn about Sumdog and games on Topmarks. We will be learning how to show respect for others and of their beliefs and values.
