Primary 6a and 6b: STEM Challenge – The Tallest Structure on **Tuesday 15th November** at 9:30 – 10:30am.

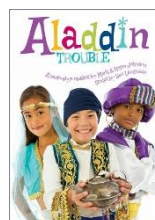
Christmas Parties
