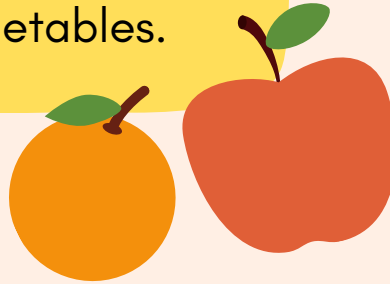

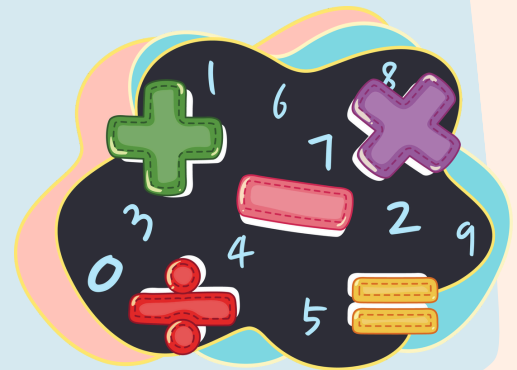
CLASS LEAFLET TERM 1

Listed below are the main areas of learning for your child's class in term 1. Please note all children learn and make progress at different rates. Some learners require further challenge, whilst others require support and consolidation of previous learning.

MATHS AND NUMERACY

- Throughout the school year P4 will develop their mental maths strategies and revise times tables.
- Place value to 1000 including rounding and ordering numbers.
- Addition to 1000.
- Measure including area.
- Shape and pattern - 2D and 3D.

- Phonics and spelling:
 - /zh/ sound (si, ge, s)
 - /a/ sound (al)
 - /aw+l/ sound (al)
 - /ch/ sound (t)
 - /i/ sound (y)
 - /s/ sound (sc, st)

LITERACY AND ENGLISH

- Writing - Narrative.

- Language features:

- sentence openers

- connectives

- proof reading, up-leveiling and redrafts

- punctuation: capital letters, full stops, commas, speech marks, apostrophes, question marks, exclamation marks.

- figurative language: similes, metaphors, alliteration, onomatopoeia.

- Reading Strategies - skimming and scanning, inference, summarising, use of punctuation when reading aloud, adding expression, control of pace, and fluency when reading aloud.
