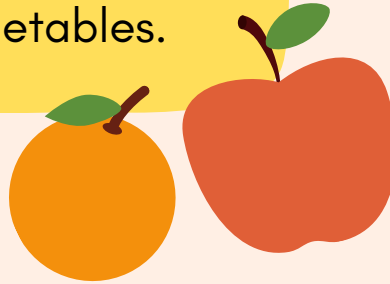

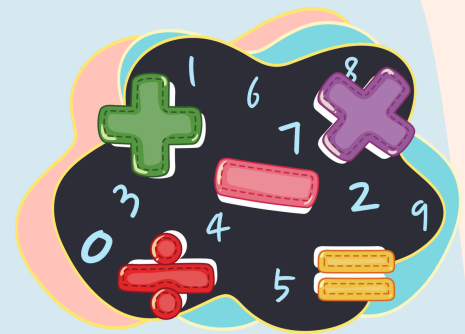

- Shape - 2D, 3D, symmetry and angles.

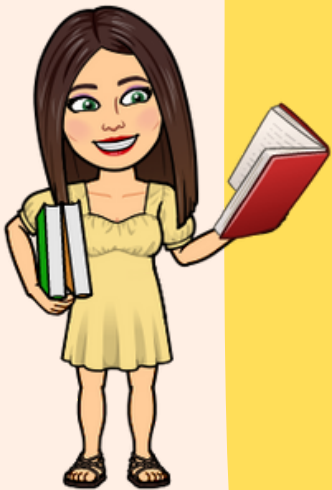
