It is everyone's responsibility to protect children



All children have the right to grow up in a caring and safe environment. All adults have a responsibility to protect children including members of the public.

PREVENT: We have a duty to stop children being drawn into terrorism.

What might make you concerned?

Most children grow up in homes where they are loved and well cared for however sometimes for a variety of reasons, a child may be being abused or neglected. If you're worried about a child's conversations, online activity, or influences, report it immediately.



What to do if you are concerned?

Children cannot always get help for themselves, they may need you to get help for them. If you are concerned about a child attending this school or nursery, please speak to the **lead Child Protection and PREVENT officers: Elyse Buchanan**, Head Teacher or **Colette Kavanagh**, Depute Headteacher
