



How to access Newark Pupil Profiles @ Home

The Newark Award Profile is a key tool designed to track and celebrate your child's progress in developing the essential skills they need for success in the modern world.

It specifically focuses on 12 'Meta Skills' and links these to the 4 capacities for learning, going beyond what is taught in regular classroom lessons. This profile is managed directly by the children themselves, using their secure Glow accounts which are only accessible by the individual pupil and the staff @ Newark Primary. This encourages them to take ownership of their own skills development and builds responsibility.

By working towards and achieving the Bronze, Silver and Gold Newark Award, your child is actively building the vital capabilities and confidence needed for life and work in the 21st century.

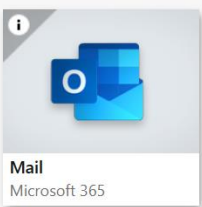
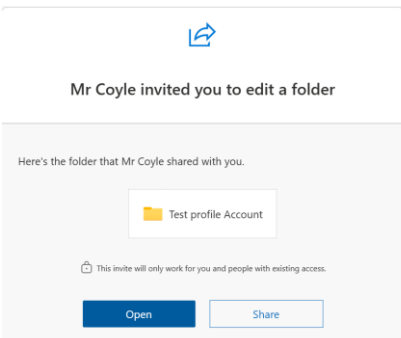
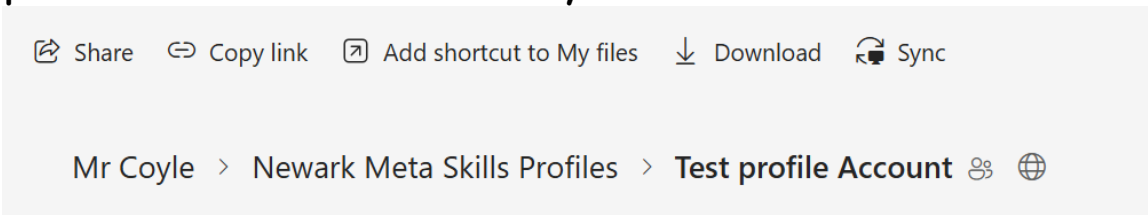
To ensure this development is continuous, the Newark Award Profile is accessible to your child at home. This allows them to monitor their progress and record achievements they gain outside of school, helping them actively recognise how their skills are used in the wider community.

Crucially, this system is designed to involve you, the parent. It provides you with a simple opportunity to comment on and celebrate the ways your child demonstrates these essential skills at home and within your local community. To ensure your involvement, we will invite parents into school during Term 2 for an opportunity to explore the profiles directly with your children, teacher and provide written / verbal feedback to them.

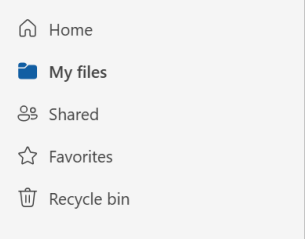
To help with this, Mr Coyle will be available from 3-3:30 on Monday's, as part of the Barnardo's family drop-in sessions, to provide support with this.

A helpful guide is attached below to fully support your young person in accessing and managing their profile from home.



<u>1.</u>	Using your browser of choice, access Glow @ Glow - Sign In
<u>2.</u>	Have your child sign in using their details provided to them by their teacher. This will take you to the glow 'launchpad'.
When accessing for the first time, follow steps 3-5.	
<u>3.</u>	Locate this image on the 'launchpad' and select it. 
<u>4.</u>	You are looking for the following email, with your child's name beside the folder, and should click on the blue button which will take you to OneDrive. 
<u>5.</u>	On the row of options at the top, you are looking to press 'Add shortcut to my files' once. 



6.	Locate this image on the 'launchpad' and select it. 
7.	On the left hand side, select the option: My files. 
8.	In here you will have a folder called 'Mr Coyle's files - PUPIL NAME'
9.	In your child's Glow folder, you will easily locate a specific document corresponding to their current stage. This document, which opens as a Word file, contains the format to:
	Track Progress: You and your child can explore the current in-class targets and see the progress being made towards them. Record Achievements: Your child can update their profile by adding any wider achievements they have made at home or in the community, linking them directly to the relevant Meta Skills. Provide Input: Crucially, this is where you, the caregiver, will have the opportunity to leave your own valuable comment, highlighting how you see your child successfully demonstrating these essential skills at home and within your local community.
