

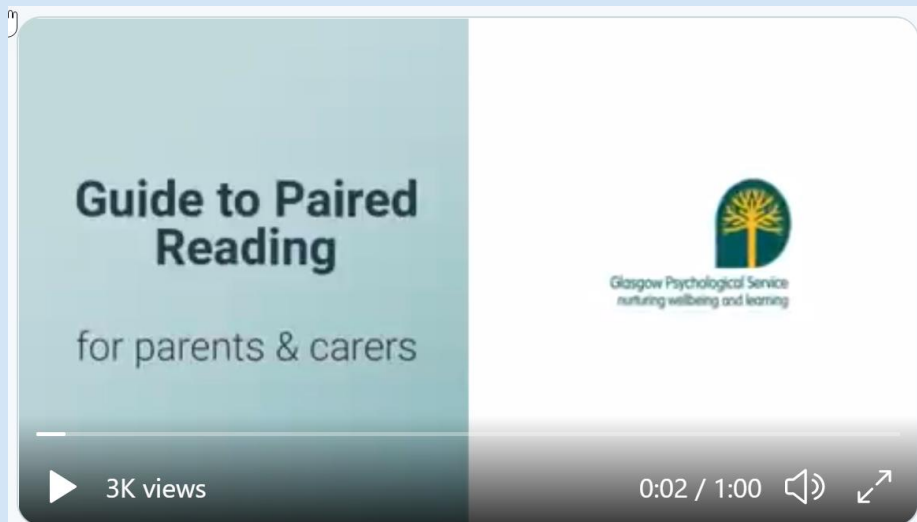
Did you know that all children's books are available for free on Audible just now?

Immersive Reader lets you:

- Change font size, text spacing, and background colour.
- Split up words into syllables.
- Highlight verbs, nouns, adjectives and sub-clauses.
- Choose between two fonts optimised to help with reading.
- Read out text aloud and change the speed of reading.

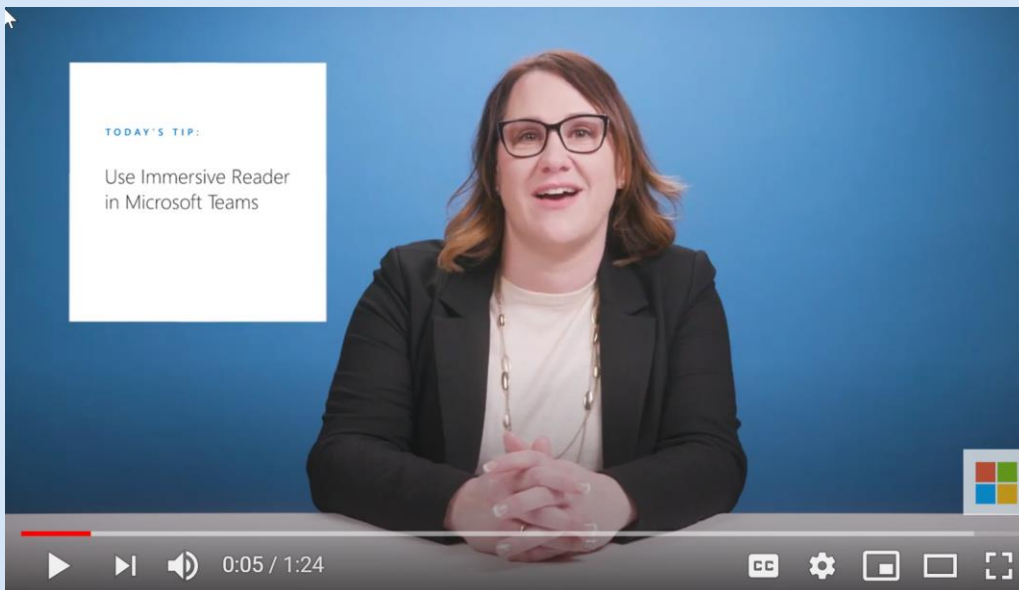




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
