School Trip to Edinburgh Roborium at Heriot-Watt University

Our S3 pupils recently enjoyed an exciting trip to the Edinburgh Roborium at Heriot-Watt University, where they explored the world of robotics and artificial intelligence! The day began with an introduction to various types of robots, followed by an impressive demonstration of a robot dog climbing stairs and interacting with students. The highlight for many was meeting Ameca, a highly advanced, AI-powered humanoid robot who engaged the pupils in conversation.

In a hands-on session, students worked together to write code to operate a robotic arm crane, successfully completing assigned tasks and showcasing their teamwork and problem-solving skills. It was an inspiring experience that left our pupils excited about the future of technology!


