#### INTRODUCING ARTICLE 42 - Everyone Must Know Children's Rights

- Governments must actively work to make sure children and adults know about the Convention on the Right's of the Child.
- The Scottish Parliament has recently incorporated the UNCRC (Children's Right's) into Scots Law. This means, decision-makers **MUST** take rights into account and children are able to challenge decisions in court, if they feel their rights are denied. The Bill is a milestone on Scotland's journey towards making rights real for every child.
- Rights are for every child – so every child and young person should know that they have them.
- Rights are there to protect and safeguard children.
- Children are empowered. Their views and voices should be listened to and respected.

**S4/5: Tues 1<sup>st</sup> & Wed 2<sup>nd</sup> April (9-6pm)**

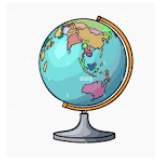


## Subject Departments Updates this week
