#### Delivery Model for Social Services Children & Young People 1 Year S6 Pupils

August 19 – November 19

- 4 afternoons per week (Tue/Wed/Thur/Fri) 1.30 pm – 4.00pm

November 19 – June 20

- 2 afternoons per week in College (this will either be Tue/Thur or Wed/Friday) 1.30 – 4.00pm
- 1 full day work placement – arranged on an individual basis to minimise disruption to other school subjects.

\*Please note that some work placements will finish before June – discussions will take place with each employer and this will be feedback to pupils.

- 1 year programme in S6 to gain an industry recognised qualification
- Achieve an NC/NPA - same level as a Higher
- Complete some units of an SVQ
- 2 of your subject choices
- Combination of school, college and work placement
- PPE/PVG and travel costs will be covered for pupils
