Literacy

P2 will continue to read their Bug Club readers, focusing on oral questioning and understanding.



In phonics we will be learning about long vowel sounds, adjectives, common and proper nouns.

The children will continue to practise letter formation and are being encouraged to write words such as their name and words they can make from their phonic work. Please encourage your child to practise forming letters accurately to improve their handwriting.

We will be focusing on the importance of capital letters, full stops and connectives in writing and will be writing letters to Santa!

We will be developing our **talking and listening skills** by taking part in a variety of discussions. This will help us work co-operatively as part of a group.

Numeracy


A very important part of numeracy work is recognising numbers and their use in the environment.

We will be learning about:

P.2:

- addition & subtraction within 20
- numbers bonds to 20
- numbers to 100 - sequencing, ordering, larger and smaller numbers, before, after and between.
- time - o'clock and half past.

Interdisciplinary Learning - Fantastic Mr Fox/ Nocturnal Animals,



We have been reading Roald Dahl's 'Fantastic Mr Fox'.

What made the farmers wild with rage? What did the invitations to Mr Fox's amazing feast look like? What animals sleep during the day and come out at night? What are the differences between the nice characters and the not so nice ones? These are just some of the activities we have been doing and lots more super lessons using Literacy, Health and Well-being, Numeracy, Technologies, PATHS and Expressive Arts.
