Literacy

Reading



This term, we will continue to use Bug Club. Our focus will be on developing greater understanding of a text using reading strategies such as; **predicting, questioning, visualising** and **summarising**! We will also continue reading aloud with fluency and expression.

Reading is an imperative part of a child's learning and so I would encourage you, as much as possible, to promote reading at home.

Talking and Listening

We will continue to develop our **talking and listening** skills by participating in reciprocal reading and cooperative learning. Children will be encouraged to think about eye contact and listening when others are speaking.

Writing

Please encourage your child to practise forming and joining letters accurately to improve their handwriting.

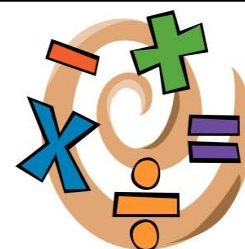
Our writing focus this term will be writing **instructions**. Perhaps you could draw your child's attention to recipes and the language they use to help people make things.

Maths

We will continue to revise, practice and consolidate place value this term.

Our main areas of focus this will be:

- Addition and subtraction using different strategies
- Sequencing numbers forwards and backwards
- Compass points and grid references
- 3D Shape

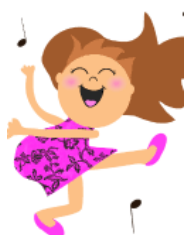


Please look for opportunities to practise these skills in everyday life.

The children will be participating in lots of Expressive Arts this term. They will be creating crafts to sell at the Christmas Fete and making Christmas cards and decorations.

The children will also be learning songs for St Andrew's Celebrations and, of course, the Christmas Nativity!

During this term the children will be learning about; relationships and friendships, bully proofing the school and our families. They will continue to learn about their feelings through the PATHs programme.
