Language

Reading

This term, we will continue to use Bug Club. Our focus will be on reading with fluency and expression. We will also be learning to read the text carefully to enable us to answer literal and inferential questions about the text.

Reading is an imperative part of a child's learning and so I would encourage you, as much as possible, to promote reading at home. Please talk to your child about their reading targets.

Talking and Listening

We will continue to develop our talking and listening skills by participating in reciprocal reading and cooperative learning.

Writing

Through our *Active Literacy Programme*, we are working to improve our writing skills. We will focus on **instructional writing** and **seasonal poetry**. Children are encouraged to use core targets during any piece of writing. This also helps to inform them of their next steps.



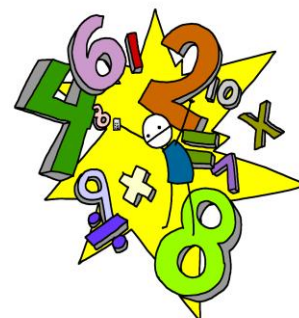
Maths

We will be revising addition, subtraction, multiplication and division - please practise number bonds and multiplication tables at home every evening.

We will be learning about:

- Symmetry
- Measure
- Choosing strategies to improve mental agility
- dividing including division with remainders

Please look for opportunities to practise these skills in everyday life.

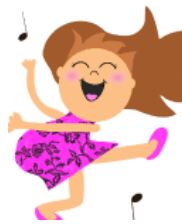


Expressive Arts
