After School Clubs

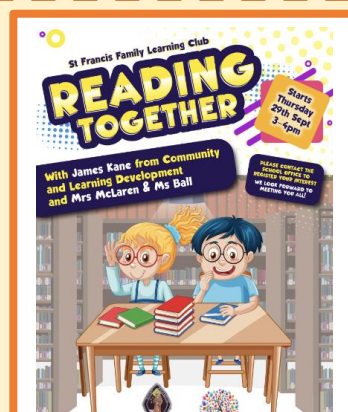

Health and Wellbeing

Developing our children's **health and wellbeing** is a very important part of our work here at St. Francis. Please help us to show the children that by "**living the values**," the whole school community can work together to value and respect each other.



As a Health Promoting School we ask you to support us by encouraging the children to make healthy choices when choosing snacks for breaks. I would ask that children **do not bring fizzy or energy drinks to school**. Children should bring a **CLEAR PLASTIC** bottle of water to drink in class. This can be refilled during the day.

PE

Children should only wear jewellery if they are able to remove this themselves on their PE day. Children are required to take part in 2 hours of PE each week as per Inverclyde Policy and will be unable to take part if they are wearing earrings. **This also applies to the wearing of false/long nails**. We take the safety of your children very seriously.

Parking restrictions/carpark/disabled spaces

Please be aware of the parking restrictions and layout at the entrance to the school. This is for the safety of our children but also to ease congestion.
