Multiplication and Division of whole numbers to two decimal places

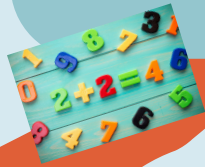
**P6** - Place value to 6 places and two decimal places including expanded notation, ordering and rounding.
