Spelling: Phoneme representations - see homework, Adding prefixes and suffixes and associated spelling rules Homophones and Latin and Greek root words Grammar P7 - Verbs (passive/active voice) Grammar P6 -adverbs, modal verbs showing possibility, prepositions and figurative language Writing - Reporsts and Persuasive Reading-fluency, skimming and scanning; finding and using information; making and organising notes Novels - Wonder, Divided City-exploring identity and diversity



P7 Fractions - Fraction of a quantity, improper fractions Decimals - Converting to percentages and fractions, calculations up to 3 decimal places Percentages - Finding a percentage of a number, using a calculator to find percentages ·Profit and Loss - Money calculations and working within a budget P6 Fractions: equivalence, simplifying fractions Decimals: place value to two decimal places; adding and subtracting; multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100; multiplying and dividing by a single digit Percentages: expressing percentages as fractions and decimals; calculating percentages of amounts using fractions.
