Placing the human rights and needs of every child and young person at the centre of education	- Review curricular offer to ensure diversity and racial literacy are evident in the school and nursery. - Maintain Right Respecting Schools Gold Award.
Improvement in children and young people's health and wellbeing	- Embed the establishment Positive Relationships Policy, producing a child friendly version. - Ensure CIRCLE Inclusive Classroom strategies are embedded in practice. - Senior Leaders to complete Signs of Safety training. - Continue to focus on whole school nurturing approaches and trauma informed practices.
Closing the attainment gap between the most and least disadvantaged	- Continue to accurately identify intervention strategies for individual children and track progress effectively. - Review processes for assessment, tracking and data analysis. - Work with Attendance Officer to implement tracker and monitor attendance more rigorously.
Improvement in skills and sustained positive school leaver destinations	- Implement Financial Literacy project (Cluster priority). - Develop a clearer understanding of Metaskills and apply them across learning. - Continue to develop and create new opportunities for pupil leadership
Improvement in attainment, particularly in literacy and numeracy	- Further enhance play pedagogy across early and first level and further progress playful approaches into second level. - Review pedagogical approaches to reading and writing and numeracy. - Further develop teacher leadership through curriculum development. - Raise awareness of Curriculum Improvement Cycle across the whole establishment - Further develop the implementation of the new Early Years Joint Framework. - Review and refresh the school's vision, values and aims alongside the curriculum rationale.
