

## Literacy Tasks

The following tasks are examples of activities that you can do. These activities are all linked to what we have been working on in class.

### Talking & Listening

- Watch a news programme (Newsround is great for P5!) and write down the key information that you learn. Try to write as much detail as you can.

### Reading

- Pick a book that you have read and write a book review.
- Pick a character from a book and create a mind map, including as many details about them as you can. What do they look like? What is their personality? What do they do in the book?
- Find tricky words in your reading book and clarify the meaning using a dictionary.
- Reading for pleasure – read any book you wish!

### Writing

- Write an imaginative story with the title, ‘Aliens Land at Whinhill!’
- Write a ‘dear diary’ entry about a day in the life of you.

### Spelling

- Revise the phonemes and their representations that we have been learning this year. Practice them in any way that works best for you. Example spelling activites are included.
