# <u>Literacy Tasks</u>

The following tasks are examples of activities that you can do. These activities are all linked to what we have been working on in class.

## <u> Talking & Listening</u>

• Watch a news programme (Newsround is great for 6/5!) and write down the key information that you learn. Try to write as much detail as you can.

## <u>Reading</u>

- Pick a book that you have read and write a book review (worksheet included).
- Pick a character from your class reading book and create a mind map, including as many details about them as you can. What do they look like? What is their personality? What do they do in the book? (worksheet included)
- Find tricky words in your reading book and clarify the meaning using a dictionary.

## <u>Writing</u>

- Write an imaginative story with the title, 'Aliens land at Whinhill'
- Write a 'dear diary' entry about a day in the life of you

## <u>Spelling</u>

• Revise the phonemes and their representations that we have been learning this year. Practice them in any way that works best for you. Example spelling activites are included.
