CAR PARKING

Inappropriate parking in and around the school continues to be a problem and is a safety risk for our children. Please note the following.

In order to ensure that we keep our children safe we request that you comply with the following:

Top Car Park

- only cars displaying disabled badge should be in the designated bays. It is important to note that the spaces are for adults who are registered for a disabled badge to exit their car and collect a child.
- this car park also facilitates the pick up and drop off for children who attend our school by contracted Inverclyde transport.
- Delivery vehicles and waste management vehicles also use this car park.

Bottom Car Park

Staff cars and visitors to the school only. When parked all visitors are required to sign in at the school office.

Help us to keep your children safe. They are precious to you and also precious to us.



DOGS

There is a strict policy that dogs are not allowed in the grounds of the school. The only exception will be an assistance dog e.g. for sight/hearing. This dog will wear a harness and will be identified as an assistance dog and will be registered with the school.

Safety in use of Internet

I would like to draw your attention to the need for ensuring your children are accessing the internet safely. We are aware that children are choosing to access material that is not age appropriate and it is important that this is monitored at home.

As we have stated before primary children are too young to use social media safely and most platforms eg. Facebook, Snapchat, Instagram etc require users to be 13 years of age. While children cannot access these at school, often the problems caused by the use of these are brought into school and have to be dealt with and challenge the friendships that children have.

If you have chosen to allow your child to use these platforms please discuss the safety aspects with them. We will continue to deliver this as part of the curriculum.
