We have added a time capsule project into the Files section of Teams. This is made up into a booklet of different tasks. There are arts and crafts ideas and there are also writing pieces that could be complete for your daily writing task. Here is a list of the different activities that are included. Feel free to print them off or create your own.

1. Create a front cover with a title and a picture.
2. Draw a picture of yourself and your family.
3. Create a poster all about you. This should include your name, age, favourite toys, food etc

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4. Draw and write a sentence about something you have enjoyed during the time of Lockdown.
5. Draw a picture of your house and your local area. What type of things have you seen during your daily walks?
6. Draw a picture and write a sentence about some of the things you have been doing to keep busy.
7. Make a poster with the handprints of everyone in your house. You could draw around your hands or use paint to print them.
8. Draw about a special occasion you have celebrated e.g. Easter, birthday and a write a sentence about it.
9. Think of some questions to ask your parents about Lockdown e.g. What activities have you most enjoyed doing? How have you felt about home schooling? Draw a picture and a write a sentence about what your parents have enjoyed doing during Lockdown.

Encourage your child to check that they have a capital letter, finger spaces and a full stop at the end of each sentence. Ask them to sound out their words and spell their common words.
