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
Reading

- Retell the story to an adult or your teddies in your own words.  
Can you record your own retelling of the story?
- Imagine that you are a reporter interviewing the Troll and the Billy Goats Gruff. What questions would you ask them? \*
- Act out the story with some family members. Try to use different voices for each of the characters.  
What would each character say? \*

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encourage your child to retell the story in their own words. They could maybe retell it to one of their teddies or a pet.

Please be aware that your child may not be able to read every single word. Encourage them to use their picture clues and sound knowledge to decode words.

- The author uses different words to describe the goats and the troll. Can you find any of the describing words? Can you think of some more?
- Choose your favourite character and write about them. \*
- Make a wanted poster for the Troll. \*
- Write about the story in short sentences. How many sentences can you write? There is a word mat to help you. \*

*Encourage your child to check that they have a capital letter, finger spaces and a full stop at the end of each sentence. Ask them to sound out their words and spell their common words. \**





Simply cross off each box as you spot them. To make it a competition, the first to get a line wins, or go for a full house!

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
**More Activities for The Three Billy Goats Gruff**
