Literacy

We will be continuing our work on developing our reading, writing and talking and listening skills. In reading, we will be exploring our class novel Flat Stanley. Through our novel, we will develop our questioning and comprehension skills. We will also be exploring the different genres that we can get and what the difference is between fiction and non-fiction books. In writing, our focus this term will be functional writing and we will be looking at how to write instructions and a letter. We will also look at being able to create character descriptions. In talking and listening, we will be looking at the features and qualities that make a good presenter and we will be sharing our learning with our peers through cross curricular opportunities.



Numeracy

We will be continuing to develop our number skills and will be focusing on being able to count and recognise a range of different numbers, as well as being able to skip count by different amounts. We will also be looking at being able to tell the time and symmetry, angles and positions.

Health and Wellbeing

In PE we will be focusing on developing our ball skills through basketball and football. Within these sports, we will also be developing our teamwork and communication skills.

As part of PATHS, we will be looking at the different emotions that we can feel and how to manage these emotions.

The focus wellbeing indicator for term 2 will be achieving and nurtured.
