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Our Learning

Numeracy

In numeracy this term we are learning to add, subtract, multiply and divide. We are learning to use a range of strategies which will help us when carrying out the four operations. We complete a number talk everyday and we share our strategies with the class. We are also learning to identify coins and notes in money and we are working on how to give change.

Literacy

Our writing focus this term is functional. We have been learning to write sets of instructions and to write a letter. We are also going to learn to use persuasive language and to use this within our writing. In reading, we are learning to use a range of strategies to help us understand the meaning of new words. We are also reading the novel, The Boggart and the Monster. We continue to use our talking and skills throughout all areas of the curriculum and we use these to help us build onto ideas of others and share our learning.
