
## P3/2 Class Newsletter Term 3

## **Literacy**

We will be continuing our work on developing our reading, writing and talking and listening skills. In reading, we will be exploring our class novel Flat Stanley and the Great Egyptian Grave Robbery. Through our novel, we will make links to our class topic, and we will continue to develop our questioning and comprehension. We will also be learning how to take notes under sub-headings. In writing, our focus this term will be imaginative writing and we will be looking at how to write a character and setting description, which will help us create our own stories. In talking and listening, we will continue to be sharing our learning with our peers through cross curricular opportunities.



### **Numeracy**

We will be continuing to develop our number skills and will be focusing on our addition and subtraction skills and the different strategies we can use to help us solve different problems. We will also be looking at being able to identify and utilise money, estimate different amounts and identify and complete patterns.

## Health and Wellbeing
