Numeracy

This term **Primary 5** will be learning to solve simple algebraic equations. We will also be working on angles, symmetry and transformation where we will be looking at a variety of different angles.

This term **Primary 4** will be learning 'equal to', 'not equal to', 'less than', 'greater than', and the related symbols.

We will also be working on angles, symmetry and transformation where we will be looking at the 4 compass points.



Literacy

Our writing focus this term is imaginative and we will be focussing on our descriptions of characters and settings.

We will continue to reinforce spelling rules, up-level our sentences and ensure they contain a connective, WOW words and the correct punctuation.

For reading we will be learning to summarise what we have read, which ties in nicely with note taking from last term. We will also be learning to recognise the features of different types of texts.
