

This term Primary 5 will be learning to use a rule to extend well known number sequences including square numbers, triangular numbers and the Fibonacci sequence. They will also be learning to display data in a clear way using a suitable scale.

This term Primary 4 will be learning to devise more involved repeating patterns or designs, using a variety of media. They will also be learning to draw simple diagrams, table and charts to display collected data.





Our writing focus this term is imaginative and functional writing. We will continue to look at similes, alliteration and onomatopoeia and add this to our writing to make it more interesting.

For reading we will be learning to retell a story in our own words. We will also be looking at the differences between fact and opinion. During reading discussions we will continue to use Blooms questioning fans to enhance our understanding of a text.

Our topic this term is The Unsinkable Ship where we will be joining the learning with the Primary 4 and Primary 5 classes.
