P3/2 Class Newsletter Term 4

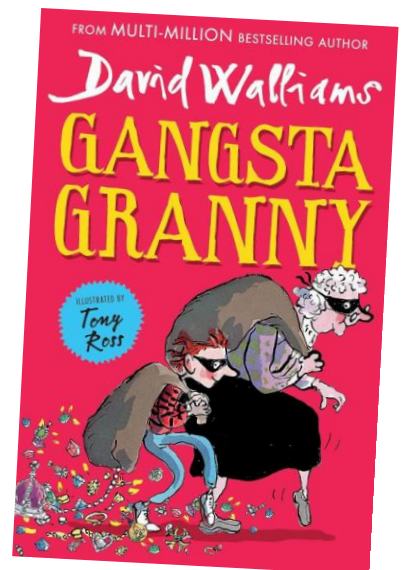

Literacy

We will be continuing to build and develop our reading, writing and talking and listening skills.

In reading, we will be taking the opportunity to engage and promote reading for pleasure. Through these opportunities we will continue to develop our questioning and comprehension skills. Our reading for pleasure class novel will be *Gangsta Granny* by David Walliams. We will also be learning how to differentiate between fact and opinion and will continue to build our summarising and note taking skills. In writing, we will be revisiting a number of writing genres and strong links will be made to our class topic as a writing stimulus. In talking and listening, we will continue to be sharing our learning with our peers through cross curricular opportunities.



Numeracy

We will be continuing to develop our number skills and will be focusing on our multiplication and division skills and the different strategies we can use to help us solve different problems. We will also be looking at the following topics; data analysis, measurement, fractions and chance and uncertainty.

Health and Wellbeing

In PE we will be focusing on developing our skills in summer games and striking and fielding sports – rounders. Within these activities we will continue to build our teamwork and communication skills. We will also provide feedback to our peers on their performance.

This term we will be following the RSHP block of lessons which focus on a range of important topics. Some topics include; feeling safe, building strong friendships and similarities and differences.
