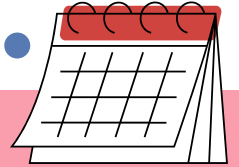

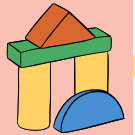


Literacy

- Writing - pencil grip and control, writing our name and personal writing with detailed pictures.
- Phonics - beginning to learn some alphabet sounds and how to form them. Start to sound out and blend words to read them.

- Talking and listening - creating our Y chart, turn taking and listening skills.

- Ordering numbers
