Literacy

In P3/2 will be continuing to work on developing our reading, writing and talking and listening skills.

In reading, we will be exploring our class novel 'The Owl Who was Afraid of the Dark'. Through our novel, we will develop our questioning and comprehension skills. We will also be exploring the different genres that we can get and what the difference is between fiction and non-fiction books.

In writing, our focus this term with be personal writing and we will be looking at remembering to write in full sentences with capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. We will also be trying to add connectives to make our writing more exciting ©.

In talking and listening, P3/2 will identify the rules of good talking and listening and produce a Y-chart for the class. We will be learning how to communicate effectively and respectfully with others.



Numeracy

We will be exploring and developing our understanding of place value and recalling the number sequencing forwards and backwards from any given number. In Beyond number, we will be learning about time.



In PE we will be focusing on developing our ball skills through football and basketball. Within these sports, we will also be developing our teamwork and communication skills. As part of PATHS, we will be looking at the different emotions that we can feel and how to manage these emotions. The focus wellbeing indicator for term 1 will be safe and healthy.
