LITEARRACHD LITERACY

Phonics

P1 - Learn the initial sounds of the alphabet and developing their knowledge of Gaelic.

P2 & P3 - Revision of alphabet sounds & phonemes. Focusing on learning new phonemes and common words.

Writing

P1 - Pencil grip and control, letter formation, writing our name and personal writing with detailed pictures.

P2 & P3 - Developing independent writing skills, and using classroom resources for support with Gaelic.

Reading

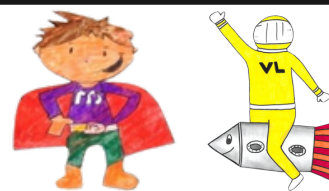
Our mathematics focus for this term is shape. Ranging from identifying 2D/3D shapes to naming their properties.
