<u>Numeracy</u>

P6 are developing their confidence and competence in strategies for addition and subtraction and we have daily number talks to reinforce our learning. We are focusing on place value of 4,5 and 6 digit numbers, building understanding of number structure and order. In our beyond number work, we are focusing on shape, looking at 2D and 3D shapes and their nets. We are extending our knowledge to look at shape in our environment and other areas of maths in the curriculum, using technologies to support this.

Literacy

We are focusing on personal writing, and will be creating pieces that reflect on events, experiences, thoughts and feelings. We are working on up levelling vocabulary, connectives, openers and punctuation to increase the maturity of our writing and make it more interesting for the reader. In reading, we are building the reciprocal reading skills of predicting, questioning, summarising and clarifying, working in our reading groups to explore and understand texts.
