LITEARRACHD LITERACY

Phonics

P1 - Continue learning the sounds of the alphabet and developing our knowledge of Gaelic.

P2 & P3 - Revision of more phonemes, and learning new phonemes and more Gaelic common words.

Writing

P1 - Letter formation and handwriting. Learning new skills in functional writing - looking at following instructions.

P2 & P3 - Developing our skills in functional writing, such as instructions and letters. Continue using classroom resources for support with Gaelic.

Reading - Talking and Listening

P1-3 - Continue developing our reading and questioning skills through different stories and texts.

P2 & P3 - Further work on comprehension skills, and learning new Gaelic vocabulary.

ÀIREAMHEACHD NUMERACY

Primary 1 will be learning numbers up to 50 and beyond. They will also be focusing on counting and writing these numbers, along with addition and subtraction. Primary 2 and primary 3 will have a further focus on place value, and addition and subtraction strategies. We will continue looking at written questions and taking part in practical activities. Primary 3 will be learning about multiplication and the times tables.

The whole class will continue using number talks to help with explaining our thinking and developing our mental agility.

In mathematics, we will be focusing on time and angles this term.

TOPAIG: Our topic focus this term will be Grianaig and our local area. We will think about some big questions we want to answer about this topic.
