Litarrachd Literacy

- This term we are focusing on personal writing, developing our understanding of facts and opinions, and note taking.
- We will be developing our skills of scanning a text, highlighting key information and organising our notes into suitable headings.
- Using research and various types of texts we will work to build an argument on different topics to debate.
- Pupils will give a personal talk based on their personal topic project completed during class time.
- We will continue to build our knowledge of phonemes in both Gaelic and English.

Àireamhachd Numeracy

- We are working on multiplication and division facts and strategies, developing these through number talks.
- We will be working on fractions this term and how this links to multiplication and division.
- For beyond number, we will be looking at time, pattern and measure.
- Time, pattern and measure will be looked at through real life context, ensuring pupils are aware of when and where these skills and knowledge are of purposeful use.

- Our focus wellbeing indicators will be 'Active' during January, 'Respected' during February and 'Responsible' during March.
- Our visible learning focus is 'Independence' and we are looking at how we can implement this across the curriculum.
- Our focus for PE this term is athletics - we will be challenging ourselves, setting goals and building upon feedback to improve our skills and results in athletics.
- We will be building an idea of ways that we do and could be doing to maintain our wellbeing and health across our lives, developing our own goals.
