LITEARRACHD LITERACY

Phonics

P1 - Continue learning the sounds of the alphabet and developing our knowledge of Gaelic.
P2 & P3 - Revision of all Gaelic phonemes covered, and looking at more Gaelic common words.

Writing

P1 - Continued work on letter formation and handwriting. Following and creating simple Gaelic instructions.

P2 & P3 - Focus on writing in the past tense, continuing with our weekly news work in Gaelic, independently. Following and creating instructions.

Reading - Talking and Listening

Developing our fluency in reading common words, and Gaelic reading books. Listening and responding to Gaelic stories. We will be creating a short Gaelic talk on a subject of our choice.

We will also be focusing on counting and writing two and three digit numbers, along with addition and subtraction with Primary 1. Primary 2 and primary 3 will have a further focus on place value, and multiplication and division strategies. Primary 3 will be learning about different times tables, and will practise these!

In mathematics, we will be focusing on money and measure this term. We will be looking at different coins and notes and how to make change. This will be through the context of a shop. We will learn about measuring lengths, looking at height and different units of measure.

CUSPAIREAN EILE OTHER CURRICULAR AREAS

TOPAIG: Our topic focus this term will be Spùinneadairean (Pirates). We will think about some big questions we want to answer about this topic for our floorbook. We will also link this to some Gaelic reading books such as "Hoigh! Cait!" Our topic will also link to Expressive Arts and we will create different pieces of art developing our skills in colour, painting and use of different materials.

MUSIC: We are going to sing lots of Gaelic songs, and learn about percussion instruments such as the boomwhackers. We will learn about keeping a steady beat.
