Literacy



Phonics

P2 will continue to apply their new phonics knowledge to their reading and writing as they learn lots of new phonemes.



Writing

As we develop as independent writers we will be focusing on writing imaginative stories, writing letters for different purposes and writing recounts like our science experiments.

Reading

We will continue to read decodable books to work on our fluency and expression, and to explore and to use non-fiction texts in our topic.

Talking and Listening

We will continue to develop our dialogic skills during discussions and will be taking part in our class assembly.

Numeracy & Maths



This term we will be consolidating all our number knowledge and be working on applying it to new situations and problems. We will be developing our understanding of larger numbers up to 1000 and skip counting in 5s, 2s and 10s.

In beyond number we will be learning about money - recognising coins, buying items and calculating change. We will also look at the language of position and movement while giving directions. Finally we will investigate symmetry.
