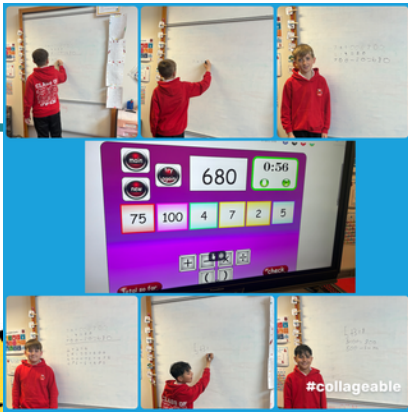

## Numeracy

This term, P6 are focusing on the 4 operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

P7 are focusing on the 4 operations which will include decimal and negative numbers. In our beyond number work, P6 are focusing on representing data, using suitable scales, from an extended range of tables, charts and graphs. P7 are comparing different displays of the same data.



## Literacy

We are focusing on discursive, persuasive and report writing. We will give balanced arguments as well as giving our opinions in our writing and evidencing our arguments with examples. In reading, we will be working on our questioning and comparing fact and opinion.

## Other Curricular Areas

This term our **topic** is The Galapagos Islands. This is a research topic where we will create factfiles about different animals on the island. Nearer the end of term we will start our mini World Cup topic where we will have a sweepstake of teams and learn about the different countries, teams and players taking part in the World Cup 2026 and of course celebrating Scotland!

In **French** we will be learning phrases related to food.

In **Science** we will be carrying out experiments investigating common conditions that increase the amount of substance that will dissolve or the speed of dissolving.

For **Expressive Arts** we will be focusing on weaving, stitching and threading using a variety of textiles. We will also be looking at warm and cool colours when creating art for our Galapagos Islands topic. Primary 7 will also be working on their singing, music, drama and presentation skills in our Leavers service production.
