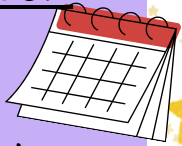

Phonics

P1 – alphabet sounds and how to write them, forming them correctly.

P2 – revision of alphabet sounds and phonemes learned before developing our knowledge further by learning new ones.

Writing

P1 – pencil grip and control, writing our name and drawing detailed pictures in our personal writing.

P2 – developing our independent writing, focusing on using the sounds and tricky words we know.

Reading

P1 – holding a book, using book words (e.g. cover, title, author etc), listening to stories.

P2 – developing our decoding skills to allow us to read text independently.

Talking and Listening

P1 & P2 – after creating our Y-chart, we will be developing turn taking and using our hand signals during class discussions.
