#### 1. Important Health & Safety Reminder:

The use of aerosol sprays in confined spaces, such as class rooms and changing rooms, can cause nose and throat irritation and, for those with asthma, can trigger more serious consequences such as coughing, wheezing, chest tightness and shortness of breath.
