SCHOOL UNIFORM/WINTER CLOTHES

If you are struggling with the cost of school uniform and the purchase of winter clothes – jackets, boots, warm clothing – please ask to speak to me or to Mr Lunan regarding a referral to Moray School Bank.

Applications cannot be made directly by families so please ask us to make this on your behalf.

School uniform is a navy blue sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan with or without the school logo. We have some items of uniform and shoes available which are pre-loved. These are at the front door; you can make a donation for these if you are able.

Our children are looking very smart as almost everyone is coming to school in their uniform. Thank you for supporting this, it really does help to promote a sense of pride in the school.



CHRISTMAS PARTIES

Christmas party dates were included in calendar sent previously. 1. Listen to Moray Firth Radio which has regularly updated information – 97.4FM.

2. Use the <u>Schools Information Telephone</u> <u>Line:</u>

Dial 0870 054 9999. Then dial in the school's PIN \sim 031100. Please be aware that calls to this number will be charged a 2p per minute service charge plus your call provider's access charge.

- This will take you to the Anderson's mailbox where you will enter a menu system.
- Dial 1 to hear information about severe weather affecting the school day.
