ALLERGY AWARENESS

We are a 'nut free' school. Please check snacks and packed lunches do not contain any nut based products e.g Nutella

BUS BAY

Please do not use the bus bay as a parking spot. It should be kept clear so the school bus can arrive and depart safely. Car parking is available behind the Community Centre, Grant Park and on Leys Road.

HEADLICE

Be vigilant about checking your child's hair each week for head lice. If you have any questions you can ask your local pharmacist or contact the school nurse at the Health Centre.

LATE ARRIVALS/ABSENCE

We all know how hectic mornings can be and the ever changing sets of traffic lights in and around the town don't help. There are many children arriving late for school each day and whilst one or two late arrivals for a child don't have too much of an impact on their learning, arriving after 9.15am for a number of days can be detrimental as teaching input will have started and the beginning of lessons are being missed.

If your child is absent please let the school office know as soon as possible – email, call or use ParentsPortal. Should we fail to hear from you by 10am we will follow Moray Council procedures and call Police Scotland to carry out a safe and well check. Please do not use Dojo for this as these messages may not be seen by teachers until later in the day.

MOBILE PHONES

We are increasingly dealing with situations in school as a result of mobile phone usage out of school. Social media messages and videos have a serious impact on children's mental health and whilst we recognise the need for mobiles for safety, the sharing of images, videos and messages which are offensive and abusive are concerning. Please look at your child's devices and talk to them about the seriousness of sharing content which is abusive/offensive. Download the Safer Schools app for further support and guidance.

SEVERE WEATHER AND POSSIBLE SCHOOL CLOSURE

If severe weather is expected and there is a chance that the school may have to close, please endeavour to undertake one of these three options:

1. Listen to Moray Firth Radio which has regularly updated information – 97.4FM.

2. Use the <u>Schools Information Telephone</u> Line:

Dial 0870 054 9999. Then dial in the school's PIN $^{\sim}$ 031100. Please be aware that calls to this number will be charged a 2p per minute service charge plus your call provider's access charge.

- This will take you to the Anderson's mailbox where you will enter a menu system.
- Dial 1 to hear information about severe weather affecting the school day.
