In-Service

The recent In-Service days took a focus on how school can go about tracking pupil progress in Literacy and Numeracy. You may have seen in the Scottish news that there are plans to reintroduce national testing which was stopped when the 5 - 14 curriculum changed to Curriculum for Excellence. Latest information is that tests will be piloted next year and in place in all schools from 2017.

Open Afternoon-New P1 Visit

We plan to hold an open afternoon on Wednesday 16th December for parents of children who will start school in August. This will run from 2.00 - 4.30pm as a drop in session. If you would like to be shown round the school at this time you are very welcome. Posters will be sent to all the pre-school centres.
