Thirteen PSA's (Personal Support Assistants) were trained in emergency paediatric first aid. This will be extremely helpful in supporting children in the playground. Open Afternoon-New P1 Visit




Building Update

We now have a total of 6 completed classrooms, along with the P1-3 library and PE Hall. Many of you have had the opportunity to see round during Parents' Evenings. Thank you for your continued understanding when we have to move classes to different entrance doors.

Message from the Building Team

We are currently working on Zone 5 within school. It is necessary to completely close off one of the corridors within school to keep everyone segregated from the works that are going on including the demolition of walls. This has meant that for a short period of time there are a reduced number of toilets for 2C, 4F/L and 4/5C Morrison Construction kindly partitioned off the toilets in this area to allow all classes using that space to be able to use these toilets rather than have to go out of the building during class times. These toilets are only used during class time so are accessed by very few children and whilst we appreciate this isn't an ideal situation it is a temporary solution during this period of work which we understand will be completed in January. We will then move onto the final zone, 2, which is due for completion by the 31st March 2017.
