This years improvement plan will include

Leadership at all levels — we shall look at how we can help the children to have a greater say in what they want in nursery and build their independence and resilience skills. We will also look at how staff can make the most of their time to provide the best outcomes for all. We will also be asking you how you want to engage as part of the nursery team.

Tracking & Monitoring – assessing how gathering information that can be shared during transition and ensuring children progress at a pace that meets their needs.

Curricular Development – looking at how we ensure a breadth and depth in all curricular areas.

You will be given the opportunity to Have Your Say on how these improvements will impact on you and your child...look out for the questionnaires!
