4.	<p><u>School Trip</u> We had a few suggestions from parents which had been looked into –</p> <p><u>Dufftown Train</u> – thanks to SM for looking into this option. However since there are no toilets on the train or at Drummair JMCL ruled it out as an option. <u>The Loft</u> – their minimum is £15/head – unfortunately the trip's budget does not stretch to this. <u>Cawdor Castle</u> – they can't provide tour guides and also the maze is closed.</p> <p><u>Brodie Castle</u> – CR met with a representative from the castle – since the school has NT membership – itl would get in FREE! And they can accommodate the school on Wed 26th June. Plan would be to have 4 groups – 2 having a tour guide of the castle, the other 2 – a tour of the grounds. After snack time they would swap round. There is a barn to use for lunch if it rains. After lunch the children would be allowed to play in both outdoor play areas. APPC would pay for ice-cream (being purchased from supermarket) and a donation be given to the Castle for providing the guide of the grounds (as this is not included in the NT membership). They have approved that games can be taken & played on the lawns if there is any spare time to fill. They also have old fashioned toys which the children can play with. Children can take some money, as there is a small shop.
