<p>What should you do?</p> <p>Complete admission form giving full details, talk to your child's teacher.</p>  <p>Make appointment to meet with the school ASN co-ordinator (Mrs Bokor), arrange to come along to ASN Parent Support Group</p>	<p>What help can be provided?</p> <p>ASN teaching input may be available, ASN Auxiliary support may be available, access to certain computer packages may be available, classroom assistants may be able to help in the classroom.</p>  <p>Sometimes pupils receive support on a 1 to 1 basis but usually small groups are made up.</p>	<p>Working with outside agencies?</p> <p>The school can do referrals for a range of support services such as Occupational Therapy, Speech and Language, Educational Psychology, Behaviour Support...</p>  <p>If you have concerns discuss with your child's class teacher and/or ASN co-ordinator.</p>
